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PROCEDURE COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS

All centers I perform procedures at are complying with all local, state, and national mandates and guidelines.

All patients will be sent for COVID-19 testing 48-72 hours before a procedure.

You will need to self-quarantine from the time of testing until after your procedure.

You should be practicing social distancing at least 6 feet from others, wear a mask when out, and wash hands frequently. You should come to your procedure wearing a mask.

Your temperature will be taken before entering the center. Only you will be allowed in the center and your escort will be asked to drop you off and then pick you up at the door. Your escort needs to wear a mask when dropping you off and picking you up.

All center staff will be wearing masks, practicing social distancing as possible while delivering care, and will be temperature checked when they enter the center.

All procedure room staff will be taking additional precautions specific to guidelines set nationally by a joint committee of gastroenterology professional organizations.

Please notify the center if you have cough, fever, sore throat, lack of smell or taste, or other respiratory symptoms within 14 days of our procedure.

Please notify the center if you have travelled from out of state in the 14 days prior to your procedure.

Please shower and shampoo your hair before coming to the facility.

Please notify the center immediately if you develop cough, fever, sore throat, lack of smell or taste, or other respiratory symptoms within 14 days after your procedure.

Please notify the center if you are diagnosed with COVID-19 within 14 days after your procedure.
